

**Slippery Jacks** are found in pine forests all over the world. They are well known and they are edible. Be careful, however, because they may give you wind! There are two species that look quite similar and they often occur together. Both are illustrated here, *Suillus luteus* has a veil, which covers the pores while they are developing and persists on the stem as a ring, while *Suillus granulatus* does not.
