



carving a passage through the rock for a few hundred metres. The Ellensbrook is a gentle stream in summer, but fills this passage to the roof in winter, overflowing into the adjacent surface channel as well.

Continue up the valley along the Cape to Cape Track that follows the Old Ellensbrook Road for about 1 km. You pass the Ellensbrook Campsite in the old meadow on the left and head gently up through an attractive stand of Karri, *Eucalyptus diversicolor*, high above the stream. When you reach a gate at the National Park boundary, turn sharp right (S) up a steep hill. The Old Road continues straight on through the Glenbourne property to Caves Road. If you have two cars, or can be dropped off at the start, this makes a delightful one-way walk. You may prefer to do this the other way round though, starting at Gilgara Homestead and walking downhill to Ellensbrook.
